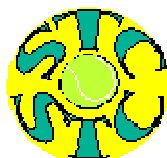

WIMBLEDON 2010: 21st June – 4th July

Wimbledon tickets are offered only to Members who have joined the British Tennis Membership.

Only adult members may enter the draws, but no stipulation is made as to who should accompany them to Wimbledon. Lincs LTA, to whom we are affiliated, allocate STC Tickets. The deadline imposed by Wimbledon is much earlier this year, April 24th.

Signed, hard copy, application slips must be returned to Penny Cooper, 8 St. Peter's Hill, Stamford PE9 2PE, by *Friday, 9th April* for inclusion in the Draw

The DRAW for tickets will be on Sunday, 11th April

Late entries may be put on the Reserve List if all the tickets are allocated on 11th April.

Adult Club members who attended the AGM will be drawn first, followed immediately by a second draw for those who did not attend the AGM.

CONDITIONS OF TICKET ISSUE

The intention is that only the eligible club member who has been allocated the ticket and an accompanying person shall use the tickets. The full page of conditions can be inspected on the club notice board.

Tickets shall not be resold or transferred. Only the successful applicant and one accompanying person must use them. Any person seeking to use a ticket in breach of the conditions will be refused entry and may be liable to legal action.

All application slips for the draws must be signed by the applicant and payment must be made by the original applicant only.

If there is less than one hour's play on the court for which tickets have been bought, the original purchaser will be entitled to a full refund by the All England Club. If there is one hour but less than two hours play, refunds will be limited to half the ticket price. **These refunds are paid automatically to the Club, which passes them on.**
