Floodlights. The lights are operated via a meter system within the clubhouse. While the use of the floodlight is free, they are turned on by placing a token into the relevant meter. The token is kept in the box at the bottom of meter. If for any reason there are no tokens in any of the boxes, please contact Carol Cotton.

Swipe cards. For security reasons we have a swipe card system of entry into the clubhouse. If you think you need a swipe card, order it on this subscription form. Each card costs £5. Obtainable at other times from Membership Secretary Carol Cotton. Please phone 765603.

Members' Calendar. A Members' Calendar is posted in the clubhouse windows and in e-bulletins. It is updated and amended from time to time. It consists of a) events throughout the year and b) a weekly programme. The weekly programme includes the times of adult and junior social sessions, group coaching sessions and team practices.

Tennis Balls. Tennis balls are provided for club-organised social sessions. Balls for privately-arranged tennis can be purchased from Carol Cotton at £4.50 per tube of four. Usually there are also well-worn balls freely available in a box in the clubhouse.

Coaching. The Club has the coaching services of five coaches. Head Coach is Carole Wilson. All the coaches are available for private coaching sessions. These can be for individuals, pairs or pre-arranged fours, and should be arranged with the coaches concerned.

Group coaching is available, generally in short courses of five weeks. Look in e-bulletins or on the notices in the clubhouse windows.

If you are not sure which coach would be appropriate for your needs, please contact Head Coach Carole Wilson or our Performance Coach Ralph Clarke.

Fees vary between £17 and £25 per hour according to the level of qualifications of the coaches.

Use of courts Members may use the 7 hard courts at all times when they are not required for use by Stamford School (generally in school hours on school days). Even during school hours courts may be available, but Stamford School has priority. The Club also has grace-and-favour use of the six Astroturf courts during the summer when the School does not require them. Experience indicates that there is always a court or two available for privately arranged games.

Club Rules & Regulations are posted in the clubhouse.

E-bulletins & Website. E-bulletins are sent at frequent intervals to members with an email address. Copies appear in the clubhouse window. Our main website is **www.stamfordtennis.co.uk**

Guests. Guests are permitted, but must be signed in the Club Diary in the clubhouse **before** play. Charges are £5 per adult and £1 per child.

Teams. The Club runs eighteen teams in local leagues. Members currently not playing in a team please indicate on this Membership Form if they would like to be considered for one of the teams.

Club tournaments. The Club runs open and closed tournaments during the season. Details are given in the newsletter and/or e-bulletin.

Social events. We have sociable American Tournaments four times a year. These are followed by buffet lunches. There are other social events which are advertised in the e-bulletins and in the clubhouse. We are open to suggestions.

Access to lower courts. For security reasons access is usually only possible via the padlocked gate by court 4. Senior members of the Club have access to the code. Otherwise entry can usually be gained on schooldays during school hours via the path beside the squash courts, accessible half-way down Conduit Road
